Banani is a non-profit making organization; all fees are used for the running expenses, upkeep of the school, its academic and service activities. Fees are invoiced in Kwacha per term and must be paid before school opening.

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Incidental Fees***- Trip fees will be charged at the start of the term on all student accounts, unless specific instructions are received indicating otherwise on email at the start of the year. Transport fees will be charged as per trips for pick up and drop off.
2. **Term Fees***-the School year has 3 terms. Term fees are to be paid before the start of the term.
3. Fees cover instructional, academic, some extra-curricular activities and boarding costs.
4. Security deposit is refundable at completion of school, if the student has no pending fees or commodities arrears.
5. Examination fees **for IGCSE** are billed separately based on the Cambridge invoice. However, a tentative payment of K15,000 will be charged to every grade 12 students account at the start of the year. **Any student who does not clear all fees in full by the end of June will not be registered for the exams.**
6. The account will only be credited after the school office receives proof of payment.
7. Fees may be settled in full at any time during the school year.
8. Additional uniforms may be billed to the student's account upon request from parents and charged based on the items collected. **If a student urgently needs a uniform, the same will be given to the student and information sent to the parent.**
9. The school offers additional and optional activities through external vendors. The fee for the same is to be paid directly to the vendor once their information is shared. The school provides the space and supervision of the activity.
10. Students with pending fees may not be permitted to go on school excursions.
11. Where a student has fee arrears and has left the school, the school has the authority to refuse admission to a sibling from the same family, till fees are cleared.
12. In circumstances as mentioned in the Handbook, if the student is expelled from school, fees are not refunded.
13. School fees, method of payment and payment deadlines are set out annually in a fee schedule. Parents/ Guardians are required to abide by the stipulations of the annual fee schedule. Late payment of fees may result in additional charges and/or suspension of a student's enrolment. Fees for each term must be paid in full before commencing the following term. Students with unpaid/outstanding fees will not be allowed to return to school after term or mid-term breaks until payments are up to date. **Please check the Parent Handbook for complete terms of reference and guidelines on payment of fees, page 16-18.**
14. **Tuck allowance**- K40 worth of tuck items (snacks) is issued to students every Tuesday and Saturday. Students are allowed to take additional stationary and toiletries from their tuck allowance where they urgently require it. These are invoiced to the account under tuck balance. When students go on trips they are given K150 from their tuck allowance as



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pocket money. Expense for redoing a student's hair, where necessary, may be taken from tuck allowance as well.

Payment options:

- a) New students who pay the full years fees before the end of the previous year attract the following discount: By October 31st attract a 7.25% discount, by 30th November a 5% discount and a 2.5% discount if paid by December 31st
- b) Full fees: Existing students receive a 5% discount on payment of annual fees before December 31st of the previous academic year.
- c) Payment Plan: 50 % of the term fees may be paid, with a written payment plan attracting a 10% service charge on the running balance. **Complete term fees need to be cleared by the end of mid-term break.**
- d) 10% discount is given to one sibling of the same immediate family.
- e) 5% is given for the introduction of new students from an existing parent's family, friends or contacts.
- f) **No combination of discounts may attract more than 15% discount per child.**
- g) 5 % Alumni discounts given on the first year's fees.
- h) All discounts are applicable for one academic year and on tuition fees only.
- i) All fees that are not paid in time will accrue a 10% service charge in the first month and a cumulative 15% service charge in the second month, after which the child will have to be taken home till fees are cleared.
- j) **No child will be admitted to school where there are pending school fees.**
- k) No fee will be returned if a child is asked to leave school for disciplinary issues.
